Duration: 2 weeks - 3 months

Types of sites: community, hospital, clinical, industry, research



Student Exchange Program

Application Process

Outgoing: Application form available in the Fall; APhA-ASP can send 3 students for every 2 students hosted

Incoming: application begins in the Fall

- Sign up to become a host site





 - International student pharmacists learn about pharmacy practice in US


