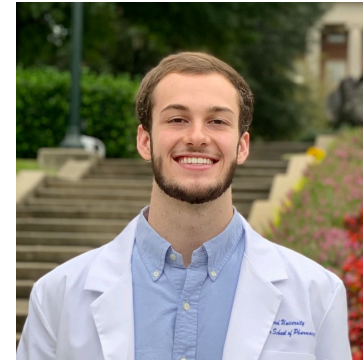

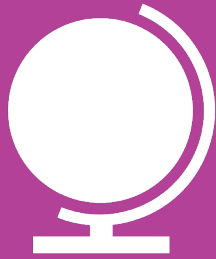

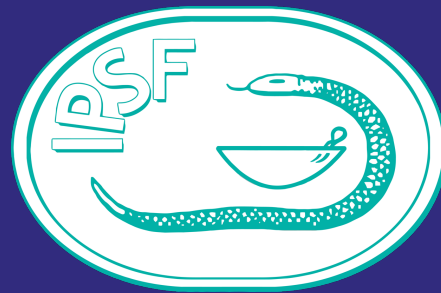

Application Process

Outgoing: Application form available in the Fall;
APhA-ASP can send 3 students for every 2 students hosted

Incoming: application begins in the Fall

- Sign up to become a host site

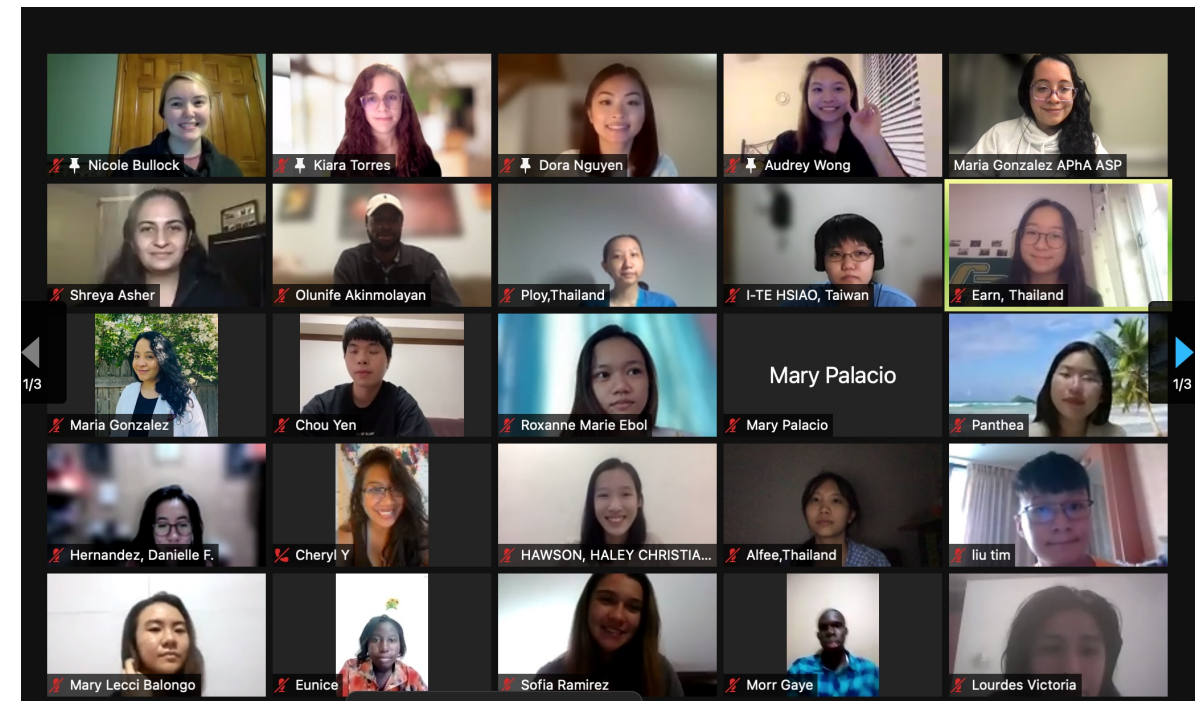

Connect with students!

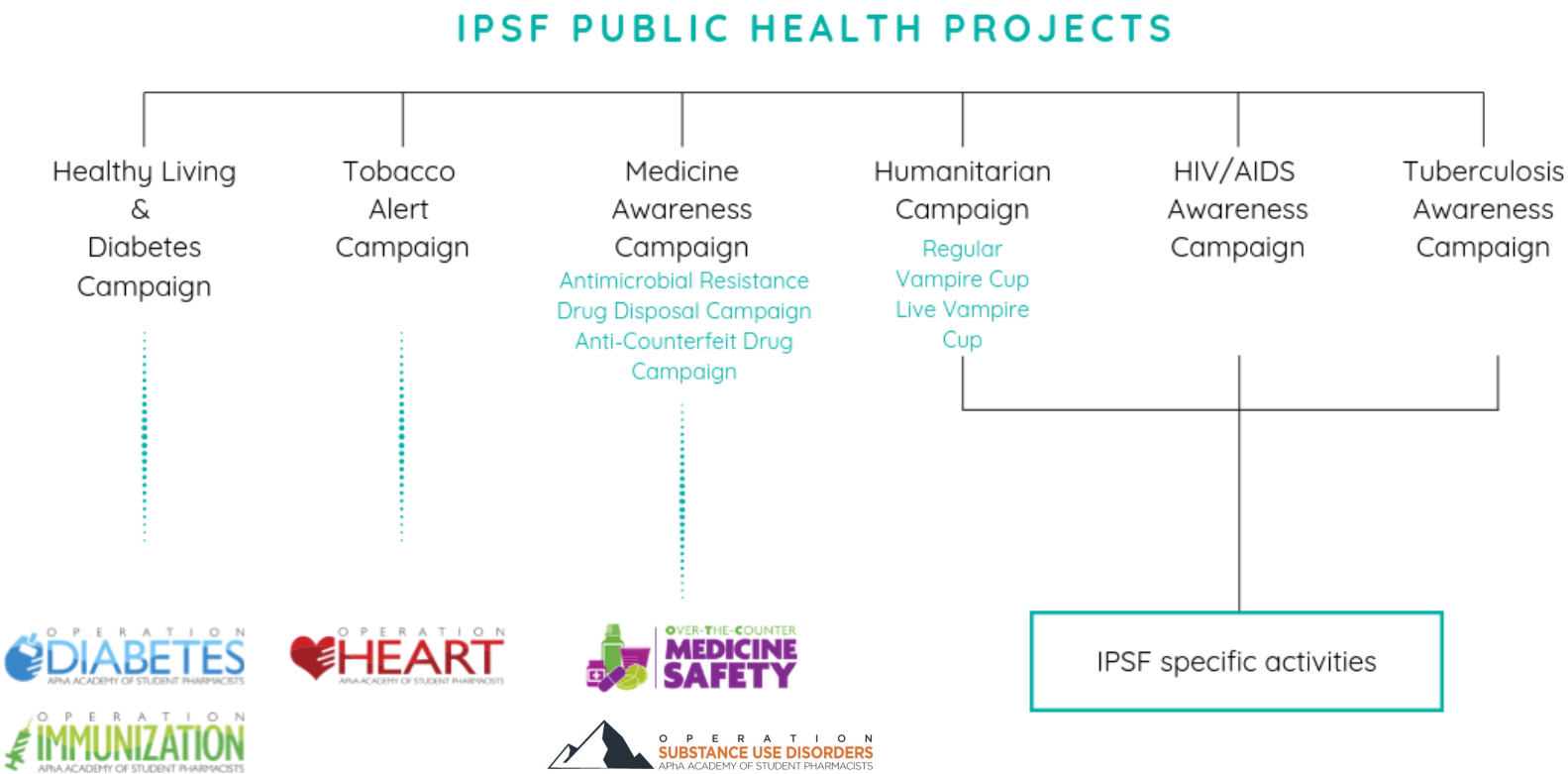
Encourage communication and personal relationships between student pharmacists in IPSF without having to travel across the globe physically!

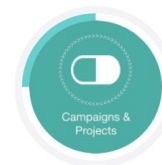
