- Started in 2021 (Women's Health Campaign 2018)
- 2021-2022 Stats
 - 90 chapters participated
 - 6,477 student pharmacists participated
 - 321 faculty and staff members participated
 - 89 pharmacists participated
 - 18,177 individuals educated through Operation Reproductive Health

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- 3,259 on HPV vaccination
- 4,709 on cancer prevention
- 2,261 on contraception topics
- 1,571,879 individuals reached through public relations initiatives


